New York City Sanitation worker Anatoly Zaborsky, 60, of Elmhurst, was arraigned last night in Queens Criminal Court in Kew Gardens on charges of fourth-degree criminal mischief, second-degree reckless endangerment and driving while intoxicated. Judge Mary O'Donohue, who presided at the arraignment, released the defendant on his own recognizance. Zaborsky is scheduled to return to court on March 14, 2006 and appear in Court AP5.

According to the criminal complaint filed in the case, it is alleged that Zaborsky operated a snow plow following last Sunday's blizzard while intoxicated and striking two automobiles and injuring a driver.

It should be noted that a criminal complaint is merely an accusation and that a defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty.
